What is the SMMP?

SMMP is a free service that helps overseas skilled professionals to increase career opportunities through work placement and /or mentoring

Who can join?

- Skilled migrant with overseas professional qualification
- If your first language is not English
- Be a permanent resident of Australia
- Have arrived in Australia within the past five years
- Have minimum IELTS score of 6.5

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM HELP ME?

- Access to local volunteer work experience (70 hours)
- One-to-one mentoring
- Career planning and advice
